Tuition Assistance Families: Please make sure that you understand the family responsibility for receiving tuition assistance. You are responsible to raise an additional \$300.00 this school year. Your contact will be Mrs. Maria Osorio (619) 517-9745. You must set-up and get approval for all fundraising activities.

14th Annual OLS walk-a-thon: Our annual walk-a-thon was held on Monday, September 30th at Golden Hills Recreational Center. Remember this is a mandatory fundraiser. All students are required to turn in a minimum of \$50.00 in pledges for this event. Due date for all pledge money is Friday, October 25, 2019.

<u>OLG Fiesta tickets</u>: The tickets for this year's OLG Fiesta will be sent out today. Please check your envelope for them. This is not mandatory but every ticket you sell, the proceeds go back to the school. This is a great opportunity to raise the \$300.00 fundraising fee for receiving tuition assistance. After-School Care: We will be offering after-school care for all students this year for a monthly contribution of \$120.00 per child. This contribution is tax deductible and will be included in your Smart Tuition bill for each month. Children not enrolled or without up-to-date contributions will not be allowed to stay for this program. Enrollment forms will be available the first week of school. Opportunities to have daycare paid for through CDA (Child Development Associates) is possible if you meet the requirements.
