14th Annual OLS walk-a-thon: Our annual walk-a-thon was held on Monday, September 30th at Golden Hills Recreational Center. Remember this is a *mandatory* fundraiser. All students are required to turn in a minimum of \$50.00 in pledges for this event. Ask your family and friends to help support this fundraiser.
