

For over 100 years, Catholic education has thrived in the communities of Sherman Heights and Logan Heights. We were blessed by two groups of Sisters - the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet and the Sisters of St. Francis of Philadelphia, who pioneered both Our Lady of Angels Catholic School (1912) and Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic School (1945). Facing adversity in the early 1970's, Pastors Fr. Richard Brown, SJ and Fr. Donald Kulleck took a gamble and merged both schools to become Our Lady's School. Two campuses, one school and one large community have been the source of Catholic education in the heart of San Diego for over a century. Today, the school continues to thrive and works hard to offer a Catholic education and an experience that will help form young men and women for the world.

For many of us, our OLS education was instrumental in preparing a solid foundation upon from which we would draw to shape our spiritual identity. Much of that foundation lay in the things we learned – faith, community and love. And, throughout this journey, we developed lifelong friendships.
