13th Annual OLS walk-a-thon:

Our annual walk-a-thon will be held on Monday, **October 1st** at Golden Hills Recreational Center. Pledge forms and guidelines for this year's walk-a-thon will be in the Wednesday envelope soon. Remember this is a **mandatory fundraiser**. All students are required to turn in a minimum of \$50.00 in pledges for this event. Due date for all pledge money is **Friday, October 26, 2018.**

After-School Care: We will be offering after-school care for all students this year for a monthly contribution of **\$120.00 per child**. This contribution is tax deductible and will be included in your Smart Tuition bill for each month. Children not enrolled or without up-to-date contributions will not be allowed to stay for this program. Enrollment forms will be available the first week of school. STAR Testing: Our students began the first round of STAR testing on Monday, September 10th. The testing will run through Friday, September 28th. Students from grades 2nd -8th will be testing in the first round. We encourage you to have your children a good night sleep and have a good breakfast in the morning during this testing period.

Fall Pictures: On Wednesday, September 19th, OLS will be having our Fall pictures taken. All students are to be in formal uniform but may wear tennis shoes on this day.
