Tuition Assistance Families:

Please make sure that you understand the family responsibility for receiving tuition assistance. You are responsible to raise an additional \$300.00 this school year. **Your contact will be Mrs. Maria Osorio (619) 517-9745.** You must set-up and get approval for all fundraising activities.
